Who Needs Homes?

Adults with developmental disabilities seeking independence who need:

- Support transitioning from family homes while learning new skills
- Care when family can no longer provide it due to age, changes, or loss
- Housing after DCF custody with state guardian support
- Ongoing supervision for safety and daily living

Support You'll Receive

Service Coordinator provides training, monthly visits, and team meetings

- Professional network including guardians, payees, and staffed services
- Community events and activities to connect with other providers and staff
- Long-term relationships - some providers have served 30+ years!

Who Can Become a Provider?

Ideal candidates have:

- Experience with disabilities, education, eldercare, healthcare, or foster care
- A generous heart and spare room
- Ability to pass background checks (criminal, driving, abuse registry)
- Home that meets or can meet safety inspection requirements

All household adults must pass background checks.

Financial Benefits

As an independent contractor, you receive:

- Difficulty of Care Stipend: \$15,000-\$60,000 annually (tax-free) based on support level needed
- Room & Board Payment: Over \$800/month paid by the person you support
- Respite Budget: Hire backup care when you need breaks. ARIS handles payroll and taxes for respite workers.
